In 1952 Frank Smith, Lester Langhans and Thomas McLaughlin founded Smith Langhans & McLaughlin, Inc. The Company was active in commercial, industrial and public works construction markets and in residential construction in the Southern Tier of New York.

In 1970 Keuka Construction Corporation, a merit shop company active in commercial and industrial construction projects in Steuben, Schuyler and Yates counties of New York and in home and cottage construction projects on Keuka Lake, New York merged with Smith Langhans & McLaughlin. Charles A. Corrao joined Keuka Construction Corporation in 1976 and in 1980 was appointed President and CEO of the Company. In 1980 the Company expanded its geographical area of operations when it formally began to conduct construction activities within the State of Pennsylvania.

Keuka Construction Corporation today continues to provide general contracting and management services to the commercial, industrial, public works and pre-engineered metal building markets as well as services to its residential customers. The Company's residential activity includes home and cottage alterations and additions and the construction of boathouses, docks and seawalls at various Finger Lake locations in Steuben, Schuyler and Yates counties of New York State.
